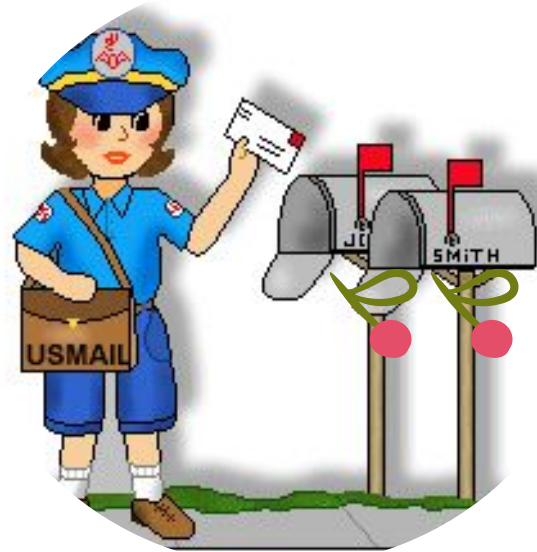

## **STEP 2: Putting it in the Envelope**

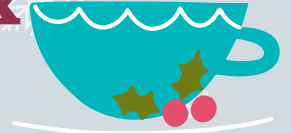


When you're done, decorate your envelope and put your letter in.
